Loosely inspired by both Greek mythology (Phaedra, daughter of Minos and Pasiphe) and the Nancy Sinatra/Lee Hazelwood duet "Some Velvet Morning", Phèdre is Hooded Fang's front man Daniel Lee, bassist April Alierno and whichever friends they kidnap for some guest appearances.

Since dropping their first record in early 2012, they have played shows with Ariel Pink and opened for Omar Souleyman. Phèdre spent the gloomiest months of last winter in Berlin, writing and recording their recently released album, Golden Age.
